



ROADSIDE RECYCLING IN WASHINGTON GROVE

Please put all recyclables including mixed paper and recyclable yard waste by the road on **WEDNESDAY by 7 AM**. For missed pickups call the Town Office 301-926-2256 or washgrove@comcast.net Yard waste is NOT collected during January and February.

Commingled Materials (plastic and metal) and Mixed Paper should be separated. The following items are all acceptable for recycling at the Montgomery County Waste Transfer Station:

Commingled Materials (plastic and metal):

#1 PET Thermoform plastic packaging such as plastic clamshell containers, bakery trays, deli containers & trays, lids, domes and cups.
Plastic durable reusable containers and lids.
Plastic flower pots, buckets, pails, jars, containers, tubs and lids.
Fruit and Vegetable containers and baskets
Plastic bottles and caps.
Non-hazardous aerosol cans.
Glass bottles and jars.
Bi-metal steel/tin cans.
Aluminum cans and foil products.

Mixed Paper:

Wax-coated milk/juice cartons, drink boxes, produce and frozen food boxes.
Hardback, paperback and telephone books.
Newspapers and inserts.
White and colored paper and shredded paper.
Unwanted mail and envelopes.
Magazines and catalogs.
Corrugated cardboard and paperboard boxes

Please rinse all containers.

Flatten all empty boxes; tie in bundles no larger than 3' x 3' and no thicker than 6" each. Acceptable materials can be combined together and placed in paper bags or small cardboard boxes.

YARD WASTE (Picked up by our Trash Contractor)

BAG IT

Place leaves, grass, brush and other yard trimmings in the large brown paper bags available at local grocery, hardware and/or home improvement stores.

CAN IT

Use reusable containers, such as trash cans. Cans must be marked "recycling". Bright green stickers are available in the Town Office.

BUNDLE IT

Brush can be tied into bundles no larger than 30" in diameter, 4' in length. Pieces may not exceed 4" in diameter.
