Hi - we live at 348 Ridge Road and very much appreciate the opportunity to comment on lower Ridge Road traffic calming device ("speed bump"). We have lived here since 2004. In that time, we have not experienced a large amount of traffic or speeding on lower Ridge Road that would warrant a speed bump. We are concerned that any supposed benefits have not been weighed against the speed bump's installation and ongoing maintenance costs (including any difficulties associated with snow removal). It would be helpful to compare the traffic on upper Ridge to that of lower Ridge to see if a speed bump would be an appropriate use of Town and taxpayer resources. Based on our observations over the last 17 years, it appears that any assumed benefits of speed bump would not exceed the costs. We welcome other perspectives, particularly if based on data.
