Subject: Speed hump on Lower Ridge Road?

Hi, Kathy. Could you please send this opinion to the Town Council, along with others that you receive? Thanks.

Dear Council Members:

I have sent ideas about the issue of a speed hump on lower Ridge Road previously, but since you are requesting opinions again, I will reiterate. First, let me say I appreciate the new "No Outlet" sign that was posted near the intersection of Ridge and Center.

The request for a speed hump on lower Ridge Road originated in worry for pedestrians below the final bend in the road. There is very little vehicle traffic below that point, and I know of no dangerous speeding incidents or near-misses. A better, cheaper solution than a speed hump would be to trim back the shrubs that impede a clear view of the road as it bends and goes downhill. A speed limit sign or a "SLOW: Pedestrians Ahead" sign there could also help.
