RESOLUTION IN COMMENDATION OF THE WORKERS AT THE WASHINGTON GROVE POST OFFICE FOR THEIR DEVOTED SERVICE DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Since early in 2020 and continuing through the present, the United States and the entire world has been subject to a pandemic of a scale not seen in more than 100 years. The COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in the deaths of hundreds of thousands in this country and severe illness of millions, while severely disrupting the daily lives of all; and

WHEREAS, The restrictions on normal commercial and personal activity resulted in significant increases in utilization of postal services which combined with the additional demands resulting from balloting by mail during the general election created substantial additional challenges for postal workers; and

WHEREAS, Despite severe risks to their own and their family's safety, and amidst the stress and challenges of increased business volume, workers at the Washington Grove post office have continued to successfully provide the outstanding service to which we are accustomed, and done so in a most helpful, gracious and kind manner as to greatly assist Town residents to endure the ongoing pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of Washington Grove, on behalf of the Town's residents, highly commend workers at the Washington Grove post office for their tireless efforts to provide the highest quality of service in the face of severe adversity while maintaining important human connections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the appropriate authorities in the United States Postal Service and the relevant Congressional Committees, and a copy posted on the bulletin board of the Washington Grove Post Office.
