Washington Grove Legislative Bond Initiative Request

Briefly describe the purpose and reason for the project:

Washington Grove seeks funds for a stormwater management project to mitigate and remediate damage to its West Woods Forest Preserve (48 acres). The Town has an FY 2022 operating budget of ~\$410,000 and a capital expense budget of ~\$220,000. The West Woods have suffered increasingly heavy runoff from storm drain outfalls entering from adjacent County subdivisions, Washington Grove Lane (County maintained), and the Town. The uncontrolled volume of stormwater runoff has accelerated and in recent years caused severe erosion of the existing streambeds, compromising mature trees along the stream channel, as well as flooded sections of the woods.
