The following are my comments on the RASEAC Committee's proposed resolution "Acknowledging Washington Grove's Racially Exclusionary Past." While I don't believe that we, either individually or collectively (as "The Town"), have the agency or perspective to "apologize" on behalf of others, it is appropriate for the Town to acknowledge its past racial issues with "regret" and commit to a more enlightened future.

The exhaustive "Whereas" list contains many references which were not specific to The Grove, while the many Grove-specific entries cite events and practices from previous centuries which have long since been repudiated.
