# **Recommending Actions**

- Drafted and submitted to the Town Council a **Resolution** Acknowledging
  Washington Grove's Racially Exclusionary Past and Committing to an Equitable and
  Inclusive Future
- Advocated for WG to formally grant **Indigenous Peoples' Day and Juneteenth** as holidays to employee
- Aided the process to **remove racially restrictive covenants** from deeds (12 filed, three in process) and advocated legislators to pass legislation to remove covenants en masse
- Contributed anti-racist, Town history, and housing options language for Comprehensive Plan
- Supported Town's application for the **Maryland Sustainability Certification**
