
## Good Afternoon.

Putting down sand isn't enough and there are better solutions available that also don't harm the environment. (example: Calcium Chloride)

Please note that the Washington Grove town website shown below notes that our taxes go towards snow removal. We need to come up with a better solution that honors the safety and needs of our citizens to safely use the roads in town. That is a basic responsibility of the town government that our tax dollars go towards. Thank you for your continued service to the town.
