

MAPLE LAKE – Minutes from Remote/Video Meeting on 04/16/2020

2020 Schedule (*Very Subject to Change*):

- Opens on Memorial Day – Week-ends only (around May 23 ??)
- Opens full-time when MCPS was scheduled to get out (June 15??)
- Closes around Labor Day (August 29?) - This may be changed if they start school earlier.??

There was a discussion about whether the lake could be open under the current Social-Distancing guidelines; how to keep germs off the Gate combination lock, and how to keep kids apart from one another. We agreed that this should be a decision made by the Mayor and Town Council.

GEESE:

- Eggs oiled on 3/29, 4/5 & 4/12. (No Geese nesting in Perlmutter's or around Maple Spring.)
- Turned on blinking light & Removed Nest
- I've been chasing the geese away daily, and it seems to work. (Hutch)

Lake Clean-Up activities (on your own – see Notice in latest Town Bulletin)

Lake is draining, so we can start cleaning on an individual basis.

(Pay attention to social-distancing guidelines.) Contact Hutch, Bruce, or Town Office for the combination.

- Pick up sticks & trash.
- Rake leaves on the beach into small piles & move them into the woods when they have dried out a bit.
- Clean out toy bin and throw away broken or ratty toys. - Done – Thanks Mary & Missy!
- Prune vines around the lake.
- Scoop up goose poop around beach, berm, island & Nicho's bench. (Anywhere that drains into Lake.)
- Roto-till beach sand. (Bruce Crise & helpers) – This could be done later after the lake fills up.

MAINTENANCE Items:

- Re-install & Checkout video surveillance equipment before Lake opens on Memorial Day.(5/23)
- Diving board – Put up 6/15 (? depending on opening schedule?)

LIFEGUARDS – Hutch & Nancy

- So far, Gray, Annika, Landon Turner, Bella Gilmore & Logan Saar have shown interest.
- Last year's Guards (Anne, Ally, Emma, Luna, Sophie, Sita, Declan, Cam) have not (but may change.)
- Put note in Bulletin looking for more Life Guards. (\$13.25/hr. is competitive)
- Purchase 2 Chairs & other Supplies. (Hutch)

SWIM LESSONS – Hutch, Tom Land (July 6 – 31, assuming it's permissible?)

- Jessica Kramer has been found as an instructor by Lainey (301) 300-5766
- Lainey can help organize lessons.
- Put notices in bulletin about sign-ups, April, May and June - sign-up forms on web-site. (Update dates.)
- Need someone to help organize sign-ups, classes & students. (Hutch will ask Jen Hix and canvas regular lake goers to help out.)

SECURITY ITEMS:

- Meet with MCPD (Kimberly Jones) & Nancy about random patrols twice or 3x a week in May, early June.
- Inner gate combo changing on April 26th – contact Hutch, Bruce, or Town Office for the new #.
- Refresh signs as needed, especially the “NO FISHING” signs. (Nancy H. & Jean P.)

Lake Guard Troll & Party Maven

- Election Day (May 9th ?) – Issue Lake Permits & Solicit Volunteers for Lake Gate opening & closing.
- Tom L. will make sign-up list for Volunteer Gate-Keepers.
- Still an issue: Managing responsible party hosts. (Most are OK, some are not.)
